



ANNOUNCEMENT OF RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY ISAN, SURIN CAMPUS

**Re: Recruitment of Applicants for the Selection Examination for the Position of
Income-Funded Employee (Academic Track)**

Position: Foreign Lecturer, Linguistics Program, Bachelor's Degree Level

Affiliation: Faculty of Management Technology

Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, wishes to recruit applicants for the selection examination for appointment as Income-Funded Employee (Academic Track), in the position of Foreign Lecturer, Linguistics Program, Bachelor's Degree level, affiliated with the Faculty of Management Technology, for one (1) vacancy. Applications will be received from September 28 to October 2, B.E. 2569 (2026), and the position-suitability examination will be held on Friday, October 9, B.E. 2569 (2026), at Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus.

Accordingly, by virtue of the authority conferred by Sections 24, 27, 29, 45, and 46 of the Rajamangala University of Technology Act, B.E. 2548 (2005), together with Order of the Council of Rajamangala University of Technology Isan No. 49/2568, dated December 4, B.E. 2568 (2025), Re: Appointment of Vice Presidents and Campus Vice Presidents of Rajamangala University of Technology Isan; and Order of Rajamangala University of Technology Isan No. 0550/2569, dated April 27, B.E. 2569 (2026), Re: Delegation of Authority to the Vice President for Surin Campus to Perform Official Duties on Behalf of the President, and Delegation of Authority Concerning the Administration of Government Divisions and Internal Units of Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, the Announcement of the Recruitment of Applicants for the Selection Examination for the Position of Income-Funded Employee (Academic Track) is hereby issued, with details as follows:

1. Position Title and Employment Details

As specified in the Details Appended to this Announcement.

2. General Qualifications and Position-Specific Qualifications of Persons Eligible to Apply for the Selection

General Qualifications

1. Be not less than 18 years of age and not more than 60 years of age (in full years).
2. Not be a bankrupt person.
3. Not be an incompetent person or a quasi-incompetent person, a person of unsound mind or of impaired mental faculties, or afflicted with any disease prescribed under the law on the regulations of civil servants.
4. Not be a holder of a political office, a committee member of a political party, or an official of a political party.
5. Not have been previously sentenced by a final judgment to a term of imprisonment for the commission of a criminal offense, except for offenses committed through negligence or petty offenses, and not be a person of dishonorable conduct offensive to society.
6. Not have been previously dismissed, discharged, or expelled from a state enterprise or any other agency of the State.

Note: On the date of executing the employment contract, a successful candidate for the position of Income-Funded Employee must not be a civil servant or an employee of any government agency, a staff member or employee of any other agency of the State or state enterprise, or a staff member or employee of a local administrative organization. In addition, the Income-Funded Employee must not serve as a managing director, a manager, or hold any other position of similar character in a partnership or company, unless the person is performing official duties or has been so assigned by the President. The successful candidate must also submit a medical certificate issued not more than one (1) month prior, indicating that the person is not afflicted with any of the diseases prohibited under the Civil Service Commission Regulation on Diseases, B.E. 2553 (2010).

3. Application

3.1 Date, Time, and Place for Receipt of Applications

1. Persons wishing to apply for the selection examination may obtain the application form at the Personnel Administration Section or download it from the website

www.surin.rmuti.ac.th. Applications will be received from September 28 to October 2, B.E. 2569 (2026), from 08:30 to 16:30 hours (on official working days). Each applicant must pay an application fee of 100 baht, which is non-refundable under any circumstances. Further information may be obtained by telephone at 044-513236, extension 1100, Personnel Administration Section.

2. Persons wishing to apply for the selection examination shall submit the completed application form and supporting documents in person at the Personnel Administration Section, Resource Administration Division, Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus.
3. In the case where the applicant is domiciled outside Surin Province and is unable to submit the application in person, the applicant may complete the online application form at <https://forms.gle/7tmab5iucDz8xoEw8> and forward the application together with all supporting documents to the Head of the Personnel Administration Section, Resource Administration Division, Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, at 145 Moo 15, Nok Mueang Sub-district, Mueang Surin District, Surin Province, Postal Code 32000. The envelope must be clearly marked at the corner "Application for Income-Funded Employee Examination." The date on which the originating post office affixes its acceptance stamp shall be deemed the date of application. The originating post office stamp must fall between September 28, B.E. 2569 (2026), and October 2, B.E. 2569 (2026); applications not conforming to these dates and times will not be considered. (Failure to submit the application and supporting documents within the prescribed period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to apply.)

3.2 Documents to be Submitted with the Application

1. One (1) recent passport-style photograph, taken bareheaded and without dark glasses, size 1 inch, taken within the last six (6) months.
2. One (1) copy of the academic transcript indicating that the applicant holds educational qualifications matching the specific qualifications for the position, and which has been approved by the person authorized to grant approval on or before the closing date for applications (originals to be presented for verification).
3. One (1) copy of the passport.
4. One (1) copy of the work permit and visa.
5. One (1) copy of any other supporting document, such as a marriage certificate or a certificate of change of name or surname (if applicable).
6. One (1) copy of a letter of certification of work experience (if applicable).

The applicant shall write “Certified True Copy” on every copy of the supporting documents submitted and shall affix his/her signature thereto.

3.3 Conditions of Application

The applicant is responsible for verifying and self-certifying that he/she genuinely possesses the general qualifications and the position-specific qualifications as prescribed in this announcement, and shall complete all particulars in the application form and submit all supporting documents fully and correctly. In the event of any error attributable to the applicant, for whatever reason, or should the educational qualifications not correspond to those required for the position applied for, thereby rendering the applicant ineligible to apply for the selection as prescribed in this announcement, the application and any resulting selection shall be deemed null and void as to that person, and the applicant shall have no right to claim any damages whatsoever.

4. Announcement of the List of Eligible Applicants and the Date, Time, and Place of the Selection Examination

Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, will announce the list of applicants eligible to sit for the selection examination on October 5, B.E. 2569 (2026), at the Administration Building and on the website <http://www.surin.rmuti.ac.th>. The selection examination is scheduled for October 9, B.E. 2569 (2026), at the Office of the Campus Director, Surin Campus.

5. Criteria and Method of Selection

The applicant shall undergo the competency assessment, in accordance with the assessment method specified in the Details Appended to this Announcement.

6. Decision Criteria

To be regarded as having passed the selection examination, an applicant must obtain a score in the Position-Specific Knowledge and Ability Section of not less than 60 percent, and a score in the Position-Suitability Section of not less than 60 percent.

7. Announcement of Names and Placement on the Eligibility List of Successful Candidates

Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, will announce the names of successful candidates in the selection examination in descending order of scores at the Administration Building and on the website. Successful candidates shall be placed on the eligibility list until such time as the University issues a written notice requiring them to report for duty for the purpose of executing an employment contract. The said eligibility list shall be cancelled or expire upon the completion of one (1) year from the date of

placement on the list, or upon the date of the new announcement of recruitment for a position of the same nature, whichever event first occurs.

8. Employment

1. Successful candidates will be employed in the order in which their names appear on the eligibility list.
2. Successful candidates must execute an employment contract in accordance with the form prescribed by Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus.
3. On the date of executing the employment contract, a successful candidate must not be a civil servant or an employee of any government agency, a staff member or employee of any other agency of the State or state enterprise, or a staff member or employee of a local administrative organization.
4. On the date of executing the employment contract, a successful candidate must submit a medical certificate issued not more than one (1) month prior, indicating that the person is not afflicted with any of the diseases prohibited under the Civil Service Commission Regulation on Diseases, B.E. 2553 (2010).

In the event that the number of successful candidates exceeds the number of vacant positions available, and a vacancy of the same or a similar nature subsequently arises, Rajamangala University of Technology Isan, Surin Campus, may consider employing the remaining successful candidates on the eligibility list or may proceed with a new selection process, as it deems appropriate.

Nature of Work

1. To be responsible for and to perform teaching duties effectively.
2. To teach foreign languages at the associate-degree or degree level, to teach other subjects at the associate-degree or degree level, and to conduct research in the field.
3. To be responsible for following up on the implementation of resolutions of meetings or on the execution of orders issued by the head of the government division.
4. To perform teaching duties with an emphasis on enhancing learners' academic achievement so as to meet the standards prescribed by the University.
5. To propose teaching plans for the assigned courses in each academic term, subject to the review and approval of the program.
6. To integrate the use of information technology in the organization of instruction so as to enhance its efficiency, and to develop learners' listening, speaking, writing, and reading skills in foreign languages.
7. To provide advice and guidance to students, parents, and community members on matters concerning education and career pursuits.
8. To supervise the use and maintenance of the assets of the government service.
9. To perform such other duties as may be assigned.
